POLICY AND PROCEDURE MANUAL
SECTION 600 – Educational Programs**

DUAL ENROLLMENT IN [EXTRACURRICULAR] ACTIVITIES/SPORTS.....POLICY 630.1

Participation in regularly scheduled interscholastic activity recognized or sanctioned by IHSAA, which are provided by the Middleton School District No. 134 may be requested by students who reside within our District boundaries, but who are not enrolled as full-time students of the Middleton School District. The student request shall adhere to the following criteria:

Definition of Extracurricular Activity/Sport: This includes any regularly scheduled interscholastic activity recognized as sanctioned by IHSAA.

A. Enrollment in extracurricular activities/sports programs:

1. A student wishing to enroll in an extracurricular activity/sport must complete an application (attached as Procedure 630.1-P1). It is incorporated herein by this reference and it may be amended annually by the Middleton School District No. 134.
2. The student wishing to enroll in an extracurricular activity/sport must present the application in person to the respective Athletic-Activity Director of the Middleton School District School, who is offering the desired activity/sport. This must be completed no later than one week before the first official practice of the activity/sport for which the student wishes to join.
3. Applications for enrollment in extracurricular activities/sports may be held by the Athletic-Activity Director until the end of the first day of the official practice of that activity/sport. If there are available positions in an activity/sport, then all non-full-time students who have applied may be asked to try out for the open position(s) in that activity/sport. Full-time Middleton School District students will not be displaced by non-full-time students.
4. It is the responsibility of the student applying for a position in an extracurricular activity/sport to obtain an application and comply with the Administrative Rules and Regulations.
5. The decision by the Athletic-Activity Director shall be **final** in selecting non-full-time students to participate in a Middleton School District extracurricular activity/sport.

B. Necessary Agreements:

Publicly Funded Charter/Private/Home Schools:

6. Prior to the participation of students in extracurricular activities offered by the Middleton School District, the public charter/private/home school and Middleton

School District must have entered into a Contract for Dual Enrollment (attached hereto as Procedure 630.1-P2). It is incorporated herein by this reference and it may be amended annually by the Middleton School District No. 134.

C. Dual Enrolled Students in Extracurricular Programs

Dual enrolled students enrolled in extracurricular activities/sports but not enrolled in curricular programs cannot be counted for purposes of Average Daily Attendance and State reimbursement. Since there is no State funding paid to any public institution for the Daily Attendance of the public charter/private/home schooled student, the student will be responsible for any costs that a fully enrolled Middleton School District student would incur as a result of participating in the extracurricular activities/sports.
